Full membership is essential for anyone keeping bees because it includes Third Party risk related to beekeeping and disease insurance if your bees have to be destroyed by a statutory order for disease. It includes membership of the British Beekeepers Association (BBKA) and much of this fee is forwarded to them for the management of beekeeping on a national basis. The remainder of the fee includes membership of the Somerset Beekeepers Association (SBKA) and Quantock Beekeepers. Our members have access to an extensive Beekeeping Library, apiary sites and all equipment that is needed for extracting honey, wax handling and up to date briefings on Beekeeping Husbandry.

Please make sure you have taken out cover for all hives in case of any increases or the insurance would be null and void.

NB. If you do not yet have bees, but intend to do so during the next year it is wise to take out full membership.
